### **Proposed development in Carrs Lane/Bush Hill N21**

A resident in Bush Hill has sent us information about a proposed development in Carrs Lane/Bush Hill N21. He writes:

*“One of the most valued areas of N21 is under threat. A planning application has been lodged in respect of an area fronting Carrs Lane and Bush Hill for the construction of four blocks of 20 flats each. This would involve the demolition of three properties (including the lovely Bush Hill Cottage), the provision of underground parking, and the remodelling of roads so as to allow ingress and egress. As a resident of The Orchard I am well aware of how popular the walk along Carrs Lane is. These huge blocks would totally destroy the leafy quietness of the area. Those of us who live nearby have been notified of the application, but I think many who live further away will want to be aware of this horrendous threat. Objections need to be lodged by 24th June.”*
